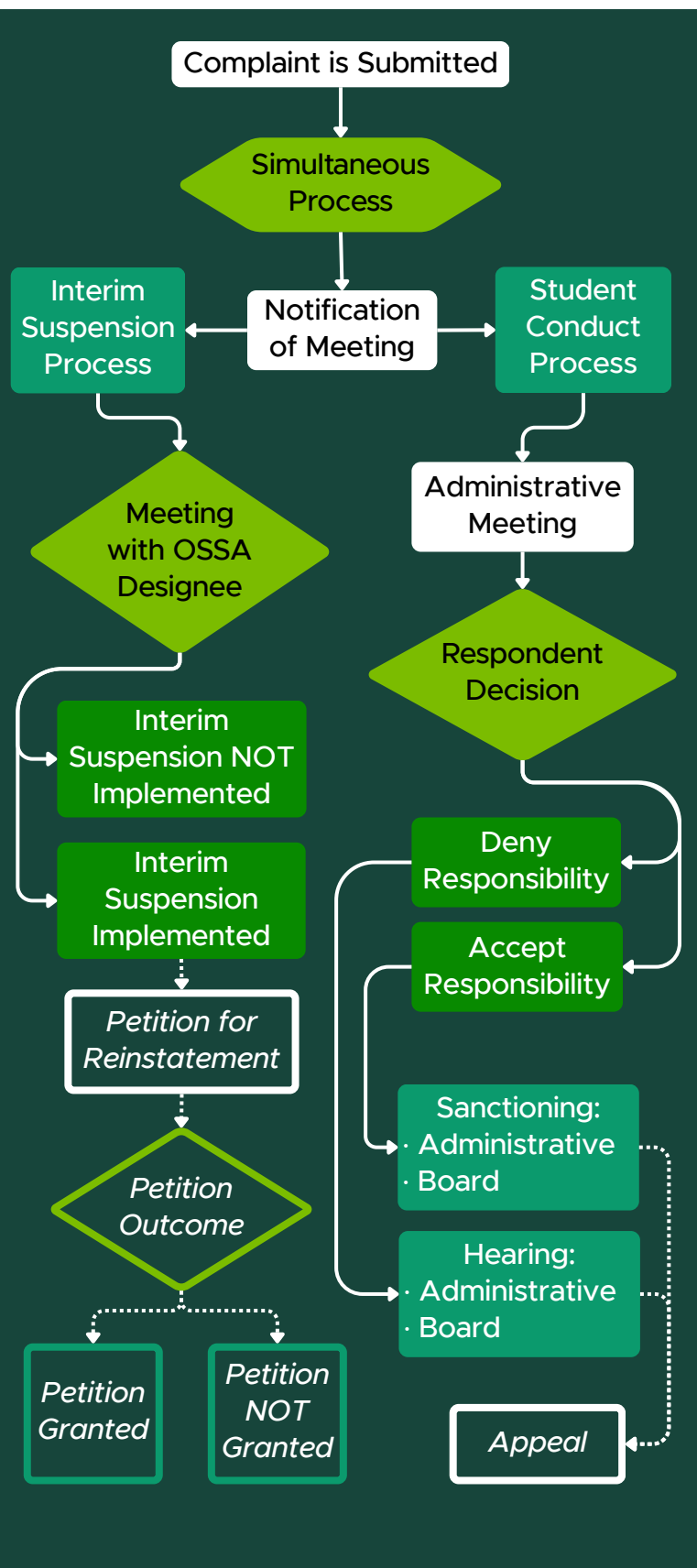


INTERIM SUSPENSION

Process Overview



COMPLAINT IS SUBMITTED

A complaint is submitted to OSSA.

SIMULTANEOUS PROCESS

The **Interim Suspension Process** and the **Student Conduct Process** occur at the **SAME TIME** regardless of the Interim Suspension decision.

NOTIFICATION OF MEETING

Notification is sent to the respondent's MSU email. The respondent has 24 hours to contact OSSA and schedule a meeting.

MEETING WITH OSSA DESIGNEE

Discussion whether respondent's continued presence is a "clear or present danger."

- **Interim Suspension NOT Implemented**
- **Interim Suspension Implemented**
 - *Suspended students may not register, attend or participate in classes (including virtual), or use/visit University facilities. Violations may result in further discipline, up to permanent dismissal.*

STUDENT CONDUCT PROCESS

PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT (OPTIONAL)

Students on "interim suspension" may petition for reinstatement (refer to letter for details).

PETITION OUTCOME

- **Petition Granted - Student is reinstated.**
- **Petition NOT Granted - Student is NOT reinstated and remains suspended.**
