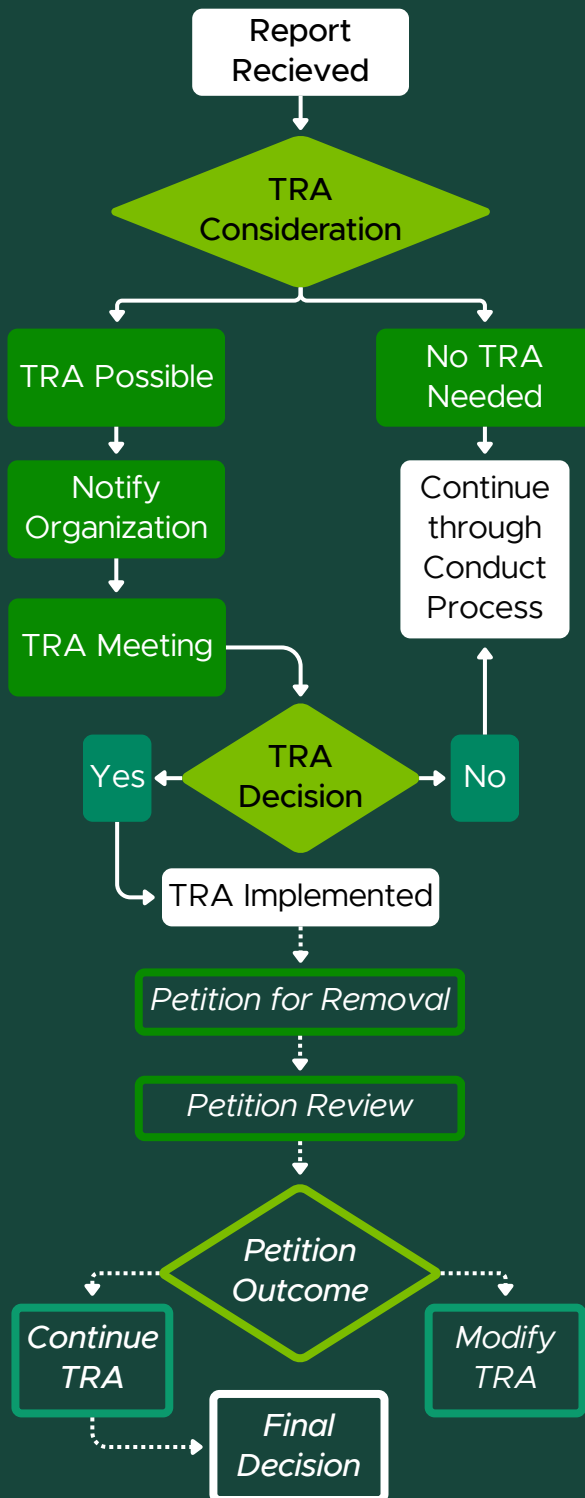


TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ACTION (TRA)

Process Overview



REPORT RECEIVED

A report alleging a violation of Student Organization Conduct Policy is received by OSSA.

TRA CONSIDERATION

Does the situation pose immediate and irreparable harm to persons or property?

- **TRA Possible**- Move through the review process
- **No TRA Needed**- Continue through the conduct process

NOTIFY ORGANIZATION

The organization president (or equivalent) is notified and instructed to schedule a meeting to discuss a potential TRA.

TRA MEETING

Organization meets with the Dean of Students (or designee) to review the situation, answer questions, and discuss interim measures.

TRA DECISION

The organization is notified of the determination, outcome, and any assigned sanctions.

TRA CONSIDERATION

Is a Temporary Restraining Action (TRA) needed?

- **Yes** - TRA is implemented
- **No** - Continue through the conduct process

TRA IMPELMENTED

One or more interim restrictions are put in place to ensure safety during the investigation.

PETITION FOR REMOVAL (OPTIONAL)

The organization submits a written petition requesting removal of TRA.

PETITION REVIEW

VP for Student Affairs (or designee) reviews the request and meets with the organization.

PETITION OUTCOME

- **Continue TRA** - No changes made
- **Modify TRA** - Changes to/ removal of TRA

FINAL DECISION:

Decision is sent in writing to the organization.
